Dental Grant Expands Recruitment Efforts

Happenings

West Central Missouri AHEC has received a grant from the Delta Dental Foundation of Missouri to increase the number of students interested in oral health careers by providing activities that expose more underrepresented and disadvantaged students to careers in dentistry. The project aims to address the growing demand for oral health professionals and improve the overall quality of oral healthcare services delivered to individuals and communities. The grant will help West Central AHEC provide career exploration activities to students, outreach and education in rural and underserved communities, provide Dental Admissions Testing (DAT) PREP for predental undergraduate students, provide scholarships to students in dental training programs and collaborate with HCC Network to provide a dental assisting training course.
